- What if my child has no experience?
  - LVA welcomes all skill levels, including beginners. Our Novice and Prep teams are perfect for those new to cheerleading, offering a supportive learning environment.
- What is the difference between NOVICE, PREP and ELITE teams?
  - Novice
    - A beginner's competitive program as well as our Tiny Novice (Ages 3-5) Program. This program offers so much fun with less time and financial commitments. As well as instate competitions only.
  - Prep
    - Prep is just that, preparing you for the highest-level teams offered at LVA. This program feeds directly into our ELITE competitive teams and is an award-winning program. This program is geared for the athlete that is excited to compete without all the traveling.
  - Prep Plus
    - A program that allows you the caliber of an elite team but with a smaller travel load.
  - ELITE
    - This program is geared toward the athlete that wants the ULTIMATE cheer experience and training. Athletes will learn tumbling, stunting and the most elite skills all while training in a fun and supportive environment. Our ELITE teams are nationally ranked and are the three-time 2020, 2021 and 2022 NCA All Star National Champions and the 2023 D2 Summit Champions.

- What if I have a vacation planned for my child and family during Summer?

- When and where do we compete and travel?

MISSING COMPETITIONS WILL RESULT IN A FEE POSTED TO YOUR ACCOUNT. Please plan family events and trips around the competition schedule. - How do I stay up to date on all things LVA?
  - LVA will send weekly and monthly updates via BAND. We also have a Facebook group page that will have information shared daily. The link to join this page is given out after your athlete has been placed on a team. In addition, follow us on Instagram, Twitter and Tik Tok. Emails will be the most used form of communication between LVA and its customers.
  
- What are the rules associated with LVA once I become a cheerleader on a team?
  - LVA will provide a copy of our rules and regulations which apply to both athletes and parents. We encourage all parents and athletes to interact amongst one another in a professional and respectful manner.
  
- How long is the cheer season at LVA?
  - Full Year Program runs June - May
  - Half Year Session 1 Program runs August - December
  - Half Year Session 2 Program runs January - May
  
- Are there opportunities for boys in cheerleading at LVA?
  - Absolutely! Cheerleading is a co-ed sport, and we encourage boys and girls alike to join our teams
  
- What does a typical practice schedule look like?
  - Practice schedules vary by team but generally include multiple practice sessions per week, focusing on tumbling, stunting, dance, and overall routine perfection.

- How are competition travel arrangements handled?\*\*)
  - Travel arrangements for competitions are the responsibility of each family, although LVA often provides guidance and recommendations for accommodations and logistics.
  
- What is the policy on attendance and commitment?\*\*)
  - LVA expects a high level of commitment and attendance from all athletes. Regular attendance at practice and competitions is crucial for team success.
  
- Can parents watch practices?
  - To ensure a focused environment for athletes, parents are not allowed in the practice area but we offer a FREE Livestream for all parents to watch their athlete in their class or practice.
